The Dog Care Clinic (DCC) is a non-profit organization recognized in Germany and Sri Lanka, dedicated to animal welfare and supporting the local population in Sri Lanka. Our Main Goals:

- **Reducing the street dog and cat population:** Through consistent castration programs, we decrease the number of stray animals.
- **Disease prevention:** Mass vaccinations help contain diseases and reduce the risk of rabies for humans and animals.
- **Treatment and care:** We care for injured and sick animals to give them a better life.
- **Raising awareness:** We promote understanding between humans and animals and advocate for responsible pet ownership.
- **Social support:** Our projects aim to help the local population in Sri Lanka as well.

Clinic Funding:

- A large portion of the costs is covered by our founder, Marina Möbius. Additional funds come from donations from animal lovers. Unfortunately, we receive no support from the Sri Lankan government, although every vaccination and castration makes an important contribution to solving the stray animal problem. Therefore, we urgently rely on donations.

Cost Overview:

- **Care for a dog:** Monthly costs vary depending on the age, health, and location of the dog. A healthy, rehomed dog costs about 20 euros per month, while the care of a severely disabled dog can be up to 280 euros.
- **Vaccinations and castrations:** On average, a vaccination costs 5 euros and a castration 30 euros. We offer these services free of charge to needy locals to ensure that no animal suffers due to financial constraints.

Transparency of Donation Usage:

- Every donation goes directly to the animals in Sri Lanka. Not a cent goes to advertising or administration. Our public relations are limited to free channels such as Facebook, Instagram, or YouTube.

More Than 'Just' Animal Welfare:

- We recognize the difficult living conditions of many people in Sri Lanka and combine our animal welfare with humanitarian aid. Our DCC 50+ program is a success story: Over 160 dogs have been placed with poor seniors who receive a monthly pension in return. This provides the dogs with a loving home and their caregivers with a secure income. We also support rehome families with food donations or school supplies for children and provide assistance in acute emergencies, such as floods or during the Corona pandemic.

Our Philosophy:

- We work exclusively on-site in Sri Lanka and do not shift the problems to Germany. Our credo is: "Help for People AND Animals".
